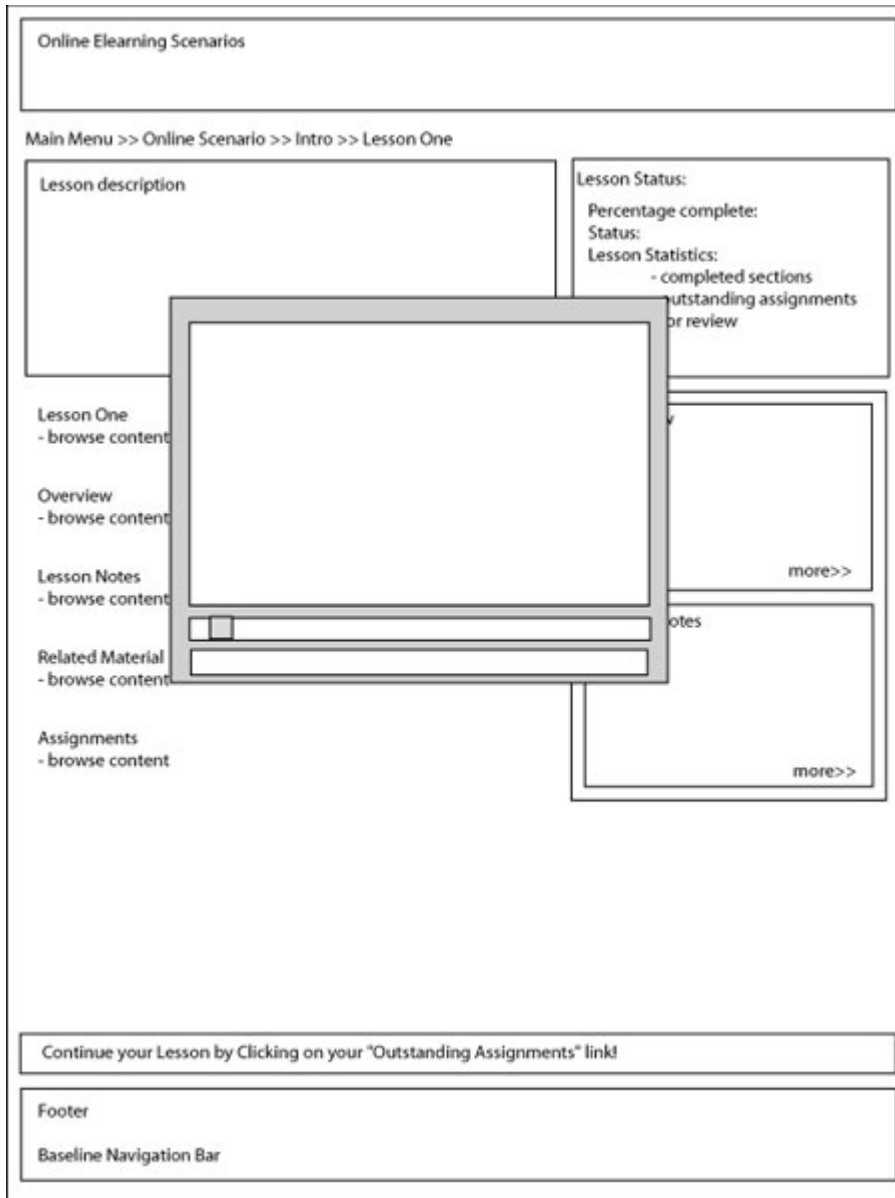

1.1.1. Purpose: Play Lesson One Clip

When the user clicks on the "View Instructional Segment" link in the left-hand sidebar under the Related Material, either Windows Media or QuickTime player will open the presentation clip in a pop up window. The pop up will also include an overview of the player instructions and a link to a "troubleshooting the movie player" within the sites help section.

1.1.3. Element Detail: Play Video Presentation

Element	Type	Input	Description/Link	Rules/Reference
Primary Navigation				Refer to top level navigational area the page.
Sub-Navigation				Refer to sub-navigation functional area of the page.
View Instructional Segment	Text link	Mouse click	User clicks on it to play video.	Window must be closed to activate page beneath.
Play	Button	Mouse click	When user clicks the "Play" button the video plays.	Video loops until another button is clicked.
Stop	Button	Mouse click	When clicked video stops.	When stopped, video returns to opening frame. Displays opening frame until another button is clicked.
Rewind	Button	Mouse click	Rewinds to opening frame.	Video automatically replays when it hits the opening screen.
Pause	Button	Mouse click	Pauses on current frame.	Video waits until another button is clicked.
Fast-Forward	Button	Mouse click	Video fast-forwards to the last frame.	Video waits until another button is clicked.
Close	Button	Mouse click	Closes the video window.
